Reminders for Spring Weather

Dog owners are required to clean up their dog's poop anywhere within the Sunwest subdivision, not just the Tot Lots. For further guidance, look in the Pets section of the Rules and Regulations. For dog owner's convenience, there are plastic bags available at the Tot Lots to collect doggy doo. Also be mindful that your neighbors may be enjoying the warmer weather by leaving their windows open. Barking dogs are a nuisance and may result in a call to the Erie police at 303-926-2821.

It's time for weeds to start popping up all over. Weeds are the most common HOA Covenants violation (perhaps in a tie for first place with trash cans being left out in sight). You can avoid that reminder letter from CSAMC by pulling them before they get big enough to notice.

Asking For Forgiveness Just Got More Expensive Than Asking For Permission

There are a number of building projects in the Sunwest subdivision that were done in the last ten years without getting prior approval from the Architecture Control Committee (ACC). Most of these projects were ultimately given approval. Some led to law suits that resulted in significant costs for the homeowner in violation of the Covenants. Please be advised that the ACC is no longer going to accept ignorance as an excuse for not getting prior approval from the ACC before starting work on a project. The ACC online request form is found at: http://sunwest-hoa.org/Architecture.asp. If a homeowner is found to have started work on a project without ACC approval that requires ACC approval, that homeowner will be fined. This is regardless of whether or not the project is ultimately approved. The amount of the fine will be determined by the ACC on a case by case basis, proportional to the severity of the violation. Please refer to the Design Review section and the Fines section of the Rules and Regulations.
